Administrative

Shelter House utilizes Administrative Volunteers to provide assistance to our ever-busy staff. Some tasks may include data entry, filing, mailings and many other special projects.

Child Care Services

Child Care services are needed across all of our shelters. Volunteers babysit during client group discussions, therapy sessions and on an emergency basis. Volunteers also lead children's groups including homework, story time and other activities.

Dining Services

Meals are provided for our clients every day. Volunteers are needed to serve meals to the residents and to clean the dining room afterwards. Your group can even sponsor or supply the meal itself!

Donation Room Attendant

As a Donation Room Volunteer, you will log and unpack new donations of clothing, hygiene items, as well as stock and organize the shelves. This is a great way to work behind the scenes and on your own!

Front Desk Receptionist

These volunteers answer the phones as well as greet families and visitors. Receptionists provide the community's first contact with the shelter so this position is ideal for friendly people with excellent customer service skills.

Kids Night

In order to facilitate Shelter House programs, Kids Night provides a creative outlet to children while parents and caretakers attend classes designed to steer them in the direction of self-sufficiency. Kids Night Volunteers provide community support with crafts, movie nights, games and more.

Tutoring

Tutors provide a continued focus on education and mentors for children in need. Working with our staff, tutors assist in developing bright futures for the children experiencing homelessness in our community.
